Charities with access to inventory can sell directly to eBay's active buying community. Charities are given discounted final value fees and funds are deposited directly into the charities managed payments account.

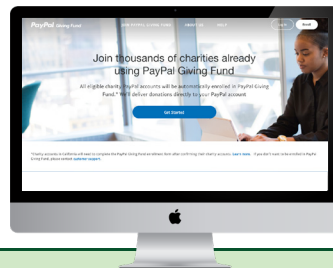
