GLIDE – What One Lunch Can Do

A FIFTY-YEAR SPIRITUAL MOVEMENT

Determined to bring life back into the dying congregation by welcoming groups including the counterculture, poor and homosexual, Reverend Cecil Williams joined GLIDE Memorial Church in the Tenderloin district of San Francisco as a minister in 1963.

For 50 years, GLIDE, the nonprofit charity organization, has grown to become an oasis that serves the poor and disenfranchised. GLIDE is unconditional in its love, support and commitment to the community it serves – providing a range of holistic services from serving nearly a million free meals a year, to providing affordable housing, free or low-cost state-of-the-art healthcare along with dozens of other programs that help to alleviate suffering and break the cycles of poverty and marginalization. In 1969, Reverend Williams and Janice Mirikitani helped launch its Daily Free Meals program, which still continues to serve three free meals a day to the poor, an average of almost 2,300 meals each day.

A PARTNERSHIP POWERED BY LOVE

In 1999, Warren Buffett was introduced to Reverend Williams, Janice Mirikitani and GLIDE through his late wife, Susan Buffett, a member of the congregation. Buffett was especially attracted to GLIDE's belief that every human being had a potential, no matter what their circumstances, and that a combination of love and time and energy and resources can produce a different human being.

In the spirit of helping to create additional meals for others, Buffett began his annual auction, the "Power Lunch with Warren Buffet," with all proceeds benefiting the GLIDE community. The winning bidder and seven companions dine with Buffett at the Smith & Wollensky steakhouse in New York.

By partnering with eBay to host the auction, GLIDE had an audience of more than 100 million users, raising record-breaking funds to support GLIDE's mission in a way that wouldn't be possible through traditional fundraising.

LIFE CHANGING RESULTS

Over the course of ten years, eBay has enabled GLIDE to raise \$14.6 million on eBay Inc. platforms – a significant amount of the money needed for GLIDE to continue to serve as a leading organization for social justice, unconditional love and improved lives.
