Helped **avoid nearly 8.2M metric tons of carbon emissions** through the sale of used and refurbished merchandise, exceeding our 8M metric tons goal\*

Achieved almost **\$25B in positive economic impact** through the sale of used & refurbished merchandise, exceeding our \$22B goal\*
