### UK BCR CONTROLLER SUMMARY (USERS)

eBay has approved binding corporate rules for Controllers (“**EU BCR-C**”), which are an internationally recognized standard providing adequate protection of personal data in multinational companies. The EU BCR-C were reviewed and approved by the Commission Nationale Pour La Protection Des Données in Luxembourg. eBay has entered into the UK BCR Addendum to the approved EU BCR-C. The UK BCR Addendum is a formal legal mechanism which extends the scope of the EU BCR-C to include transfers of personal data from eBay entities that are established in the United Kingdom or that are established in a third country but are subject to the UK GDPR. Together, the EU BCR-C, the UK BCR-C Addendum and this UK BCR-C Summary form eBay’s UK BCR (“**UK BCR-C**”).

The purpose of this UK BCR summary is to provide information to eBay users (“**Users**”) whose personal data is transferred under the UK BCR-C so that they know how their information is processed, what rights they have under the UK BCR-C and how to enforce them.

<b>Description of data transfers covered by eBay’s UK BCR</b>	<p>A description of the data transfers covered by eBay’s BCRs (including the UK BCRs) can be found in the "II. SCOPE", "III. APPLICATION OF LAWS", and "VIII. TRANSFERRING AND SHARING USER INFORMATION" of the User Corporate Rules.</p> <p>In summary:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The UK BCR-C is legally binding and apply to eBay, Inc., and affiliates, subsidiaries and joint ventures (collectively, the “<b>eBay Group</b>”, each an “<b>eBay Entity</b>”)</li><li>• The User Corporate Rules applies to user information processed in order to provide the services made available by the eBay Group. The eBay Group processes a variety of user information for these purposes, including but not limited to: email address; contact, financial, billing, transaction, shipping, identification and authentication information; communications sent to/from/via eBay Group websites; information based on users’ interaction with eBay Group websites; and other information provided via third parties or that a user provides.</li><li>• Users who choose to utilize the eBay Group’s services may review the relevant service’s Privacy Notice accessible via a link in a prominent location of each service’s website or when presented to users at the time of registration. The service’s Privacy Notice will disclose the nature</li></ul>



	and type of user information processed and transferred by the eBay Group.
